
**Dan Waldrop** is the new Exalted Ruler at the Elks club. Whatever I owe. Thanks, **Dan**.


**Program:** PP Ross Domke Introduced Kim Neimer from City of Redding, the manager of Parks and

She gets the biggest water bill in Redding, as you might imagine with all the city parks and associated infrastructure. Kim related that they are constantly repairing, adjusting, and updating sprinkler systems.

**Kim** outlined many projects that are either underway or in late planning stages. Pictured below is the planned "**Pump Park**". This is a way for mountain bikers to test and improve their skills in an urban environment. These parks have proven to be very popular and heavily used in other communities. It is currently planned to be sited in Enterprise Park.
