Program - Collaborative Economic Development

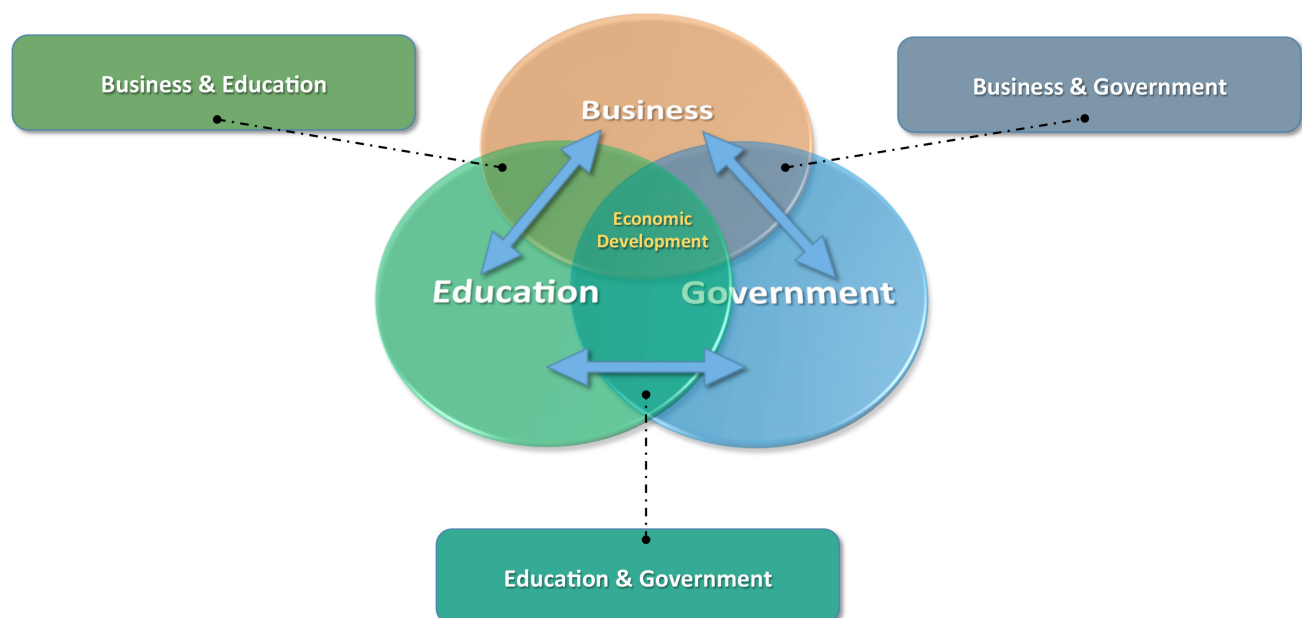
