From the handout that **Cindy** provided on the tables at today's meeting, here's information on Vocational Service within Rotary:

When professionals join a Rotary club, they do so as a representative of their particular business or profession. This gives Rotarians the dual responsibility of representing their vocation within the club and of exemplifying the ideals of Rotary within the workplace.

Vocational service focuses on:

- *Adherence to, and promotion of, the highest ethical standards in all occupations, including fair treatment of employers, employees, associates, competitors, and the public.*
- *The recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations, not just your own or those that are pursued by Rotarians.*
- *The contribution of your vocational talents to the problems and needs of society.*
- *The values expressed in The 4-Way Test and the Declaration for Rotarians in Business and Professions, which promote high ethical standards in the workplace, a central theme of Rotary throughout its history.*

Program - Lassen Volcano Adventure Camp

John Mathena introduced our program today, Redding Rotary Club member **Jennifer Finnegan**. **Jennifer** brought us up to date with one of the newest features of Lassen Volcanic National Park, the Lassen Volcano Adventure Camp.

Thanks to the Lassen Park Foundation, for over 20 years, at-risk and underserved youth have been the recipients of \$1,000 grants to experience camping in the great outdoors at Lassen Park. This year alone, over 500 kids were sponsored by the Foundation to go camping at Lassen.

Because of the success of Lassen's Youth Programs and Youth Camping Program, the Park is developing a Youth Camping Facility. The Volcano Adventure Camp amenities...tent cabins, shower facility, picnic pavilions, & amphitheater... will improve access for a wide range of youth organizations, including:

- School groups
- Educational groups
- Scouting organizations
- At-risk youth groups

Jennifer showed a map detailing the completed and future projects of the Permanent Youth Camp, a former group camp site near the north entrance of the Park. Features of the new camp include:

- Universal access pedestrian trails
- Shower facilities
- Tent cabins
- Picnic pavilions

In addition, **Jennifer** talked about our Club's upcoming family camp in October. Here are the current scheduling details:
