Polio Plus: Rotary has immunized 2.5 billion children against polio. Over \$1.5 has been spent in this effort.

Rotary Peace Centers: The foundation funds studies at the six peace centers located throughout the world. This program provides Master's Degrees or Professional Development Certificates in Conflict Resolution and the furtherance of peace.

District Grants: Funds smaller scale local projects. Our club has had many projects funded by the Foundation.

Global Grants: Funds larger scale international projects. We have participated in many of these projects over the years.

Steve encouraged Rotarians to contribute to their Paul Harris Fellowships. He emphasized that the money is well spent and carefully managed.
