
Announcements:

Program: Our own Greg Balkovek and Tom Stovall had the pleasure of attending the 2016 AirVenture in Oshkosh, Wisconsin, sponsored by the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA). The event was held from July 24 through August 1 last year at Wittman Regional Airport. It is the largest air show in the country, with over 563,000 people in attendance and some 10,000 aircraft arriving at Wittman Regional Airport and surrounding airfields during that week. AirVenture has it all when it comes to aircraft: Warbirds, Vintage, Homebuilts and Ultralights. In addition to the aircraft on display, there were daily airshows and special interviews with famous pilots. There were two interviews of particular note. Greg and Tom heard from **Bud Anderson**, a famous World War II ace, and from Bob Hoover, a famous pilot who was Chuck Yeager's hero. Greg and Tom were most interested in the Warbirds, where 371 of them were on display. Some of the famous military aircraft included the F-86, the F-4U Corsair, the AS365 Dolphin, the B-25 "Panchito" Bomber, and of course the P-51D Mustang.
