Program: **Mike Warren** and **Lindsay Myers** informed the Club about the soon to be open Sheraton Redding at Sundial Bridge Hotel. **Mike** is the President & CEO of Turtle Bay Exploration Park and **Lindsay** is the General Manager of the Sheraton Redding Hotel. The hotel project has three main goals: (1) Create a new revenue stream for Turtle Bay; (2) Serve as a compliment to Turtle Bay's facilities; and (3) Create new local job opportunities. After many twists and turns, construction began on the hotel in 2015 and it is now expected to open in late 2017 or early 2018. The facility will be a four star hotel, with 130 rooms including six suites. There will be a restaurant with the hotel specializing in Mediterranean and California cuisine. Other amenities include: (1) a large swimming pool with an outdoor Jacuzzi; (2) a 4,000 square foot Ballroom/Meeting Space with doors opening to the pool/patio area for evening events; (3) a 1,000 square foot workout room with a view of the pool and Paul Bunyan's Forest Camp; (4) an outdoor event location for weddings, craft fairs and art shows; and (5) an executive 1,200 square foot preferred guest lounge on the third floor. Income generated from the hotel and restaurant will provide Turtle Bay with a new, ongoing revenue stream, helping Turtle Bay achieve greater independence and sustainability as a non-profit organization. Thank you **Mike** and **Lindsay** for an interesting presentation about this new addition to Shasta County.


