Getting to the Root of the Problem

Rush Lenroot has been an active member of Redding Rotary since June, 1982, when his sponsor Dr. Dick Ellis got him involved, and during the Presidency of Ed Duggan. Rush has been involved ever since and encourages his fellows to participate in everything that you can. Rotary will expand horizons and Rush believes that hands-on involvement is key to really enjoying Rotary.

Born and raised in Wisconsin, Rush commented that it was a "little colder than here, and Redding doesn't have quite the same insect population." He attended the University of Wisconsin, and Northwestern University, and earned a degree in Doctor of Dentistry. He was then drafted and was off to Boot Camp, where he had fun shooting all the guns, crawling through the mud and barbed wire. He explained that "If you look at 'Mash', that's how it was from 1961-64." Fortunately, he was deployed to Germany. The U.S. dollar was worth a little over 4 Deutsche marks at that time, and he was able to purchase a bicycle and travel all over Germany in his free time. He stayed in pensions (similar to hostels), and sometimes got to live with the local people. These experiences certainly contributed to his lifelong love of the outdoors, with cycling, hiking, gardening, golf, tennis, canoeing and cultural exchanges with foreign people.

During this time, he met his future wife, Hollie, who was serving in the USO Special Services. Hollie was from Fresno and graduated from Stanford with a degree in economics. Rush was playing cards in the BOQ (Bachelor Officers Quarters) and the guys drew straws to see who was going to find a jeep and drive Hollie to military housing area. Rush said he drew the short straw (lucky man). They were married in March, 1963, in Switzerland. Once he was discharged they returned briefly to Wisconsin where they soon decided the climate of Fresno was more appealing.

Returning to school, Rush performed graduate work in family dentistry at University of Southern California. In 1965 Hollie and Rush moved to Redding and started a family dentistry practice. From 1968 to 1982, while still practicing in Redding, he took a position as an instructor (Assistant Professor) in the Endodontic Department at the Dental School at the University of California, San Francisco. There Rush became Board qualified and passed the Endodontic Specialty Board. He loved it.

"Working with these kids was just terrific," he says, despite the driving to and from the Bay Area. He met colleagues from all over and was soon part of the, "Society of Fly Fishing Endodontists." Beginning in 1978 Rush limited his practice to Endodontics. On the last day of 1999 Rush retired after 35 years.

Rush and Hollie are proud parents of two. Their daughter Rhoshel is in a medical doctor with a specialty in psychiatry and is a research professor. She was at the University of New South Wales, Sydney, Australia, but is going to return to the

US to take the position of professor at the University of New Mexico at Albuquerque. Their son, Rand, is an electrical engineer for Intel. Rush says, "I don't understand what in the world he does". Neither Rhoshel nor Rand are married and there are no Lenroot grandchildren.

Both Rush and Hollie have been active community members. Hollie has served on various committees, including the local school board. They love the outdoors. Arthritis has presented some limitations for Rush, but he is adept at yoga on the paddleboard and gardening.

When it comes to Rotary, getting involved and active is the key. The Lenroots enjoy hosting the visiting exchange students through the Rotary I-House team. They have had Japanese, Chinese and Greek students. Rush says that this activity is, "lots of fun!"

Rush has served as Board member and team captain; currently he is the chair of our Club History Committee. He has actively participated in Thanksgiving project, hands-on community projects, and is a key member of the "stream team". Rush is also a long-time member of the Rotary hiking group. He encourages all Rotarians to participate in everything possible. Rush really is an example of the Four Way Test, especially through his personal building of good will, better relationships, and dedicating himself to the benefit of all concerned.



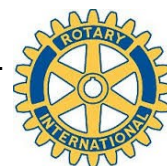
