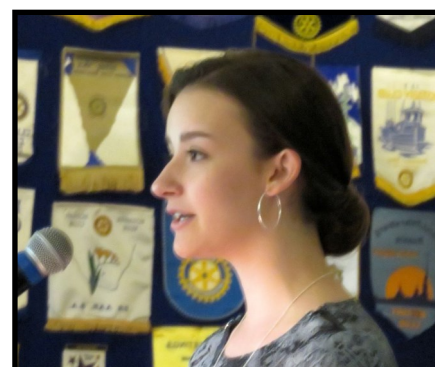




Entire Meeting is a Salute to Students

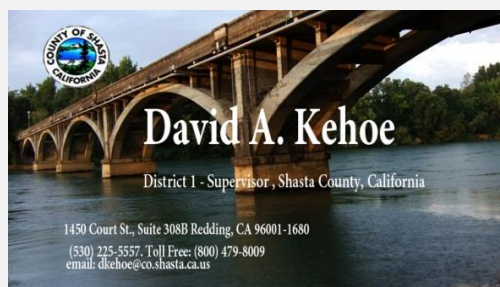
