



California Soccer Park



Guest speaker Chad New, Executive Director of the California Soccer Park, updated Redding Rotary on the current state of the park. Upon entering the Park, the guests will find paved walkways, elevated seating around the fields, four NCAA sized lighted fields, a full service restaurant and over 2000 square feet of covered seating, equipped with ceiling fans and misters

People come from out of state to play soccer at our park. This is a tremendous benefit to the Redding community economically. In 2017 "The Smash Cup" event brought in over 50 teams from three states. It amounted to 2,190 visitors. The estimated impact for the Redding area was \$340,548.00. Every time there is an event, camp or game that brings people into Redding from out-of-town there is the initial impact from direct spending (lodging, food, entertainment), followed by secondary impact by the redistribution of the initial funds, between local business, households and persons via income earned and spent on local goods.



It was originally called the Redding Soccer Park. In 2005, The Shasta Regional Soccer Association was formed as a non-profit to operate The California Soccer Park. The park opened in March 2007. The SRSA is a nine member volunteer board made up of business professionals in our community. The President is Bryan Erickson.

The four NCAA soccer / lacrosse fields have been reconditioned with modern artificial grass surfaces. The facilities include 3/4 of a mile concrete path around the entire perimeter of the park. There is a front office and conference room, snack - bar, grand stand seating, playground and restrooms.

Not only do teams come from out of state to participate in the events, local schools and groups use the park on a permanent basis. The California Soccer Park is the home of Foothill HS and Jr. High league tournaments. Many groups use the park for practice and entertainment.

Men's and Women's semi - pro teams will be launching in 2019. Almost everything associated with the park has been upgraded or made new. Our goal is to promote and improve the participants health, whether it be physical, emotional or mental.

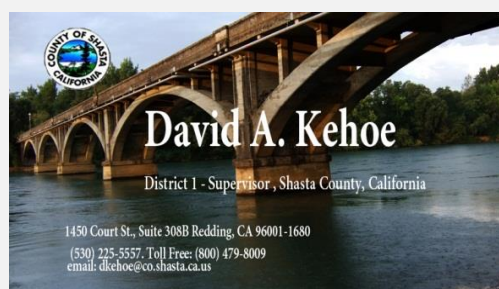
