To visit **Azalea Trail**, find Lake Redding Drive, a left off from Harlan Drive which is a left off from Quartz Hill after the Benton Drive intersection at Lake Redding Golf Course. Proceed on Lake Redding Drive until it crosses Carter Creek. Park. Walk down either of two asphalt connectors to the North Sacramento River Trail (NSRT). Turn right and walk upstream until a large "Azalea Trail" (AT) sign is viewed beside a park bench at the River edge. Distance is may be forty yards from the Creek to the bench. Follow the Trail upstream to the upstream bench at Fritchle Lagoon and return to Carter Creek by using the asphalt NSRT. "Azalea

Related and also in full glory are the approximate ten acres of **Rotary California Poppies** blooming stelhorst Open Space. Entry to these 80 acres is from either side of Benton Bridge south approach. Community Garden side (east or downstream) is the most direct. Park and walk the wood chip trail around the chain link fence until reaching the gravel A. C. I. D. Dam access road. Poppies are on both sides of the short gravel road and line the property margin to the south not well seen from the road, but easily reached by crossing the pasture which will have mowed connectors between the poppies and the gravel by Noon this coming Wednesday, 9 May.

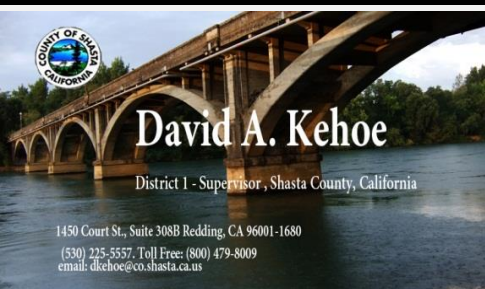
