of the Integrated Substance Abuse Program at Shasta Community Health Center. **Dr. Stockton** began practicing addiction medicine seven years ago. She informed the Club about the nature of addiction and effective methods for treatment. Drug addiction is a growing problem in Shasta County. Drug overdose is the leading cause of accidental death in the County. One in four fatal car accidents involve drug impairment. Shasta County has the highest rate in California of babies born to drug addicted mothers. In order to effectively address the problem, we need to understand the nature of addiction. Drug addiction is not a moral failing or a character flaw. It involves both a chemical component in the brain, as well as an environmental component. For example, persons from solid family backgrounds will generally not become addicted to drugs after using them once or twice. But coming from a difficult environment makes it

more likely to lead to drug addiction. Effective addiction treatment is designed to address both (1) the chemical aspects, and (2) the environmental aspects. Medication treatment is provided to stabilize the person. Once stabilized, behavioral treatment is provided to address the underlying environmental concerns. Addiction is a chronic disease, affected by lifestyle changes, and lasting years. In that respect, it is like diabetes. The more we understand the nature of addiction, the more we are able to offer effective treatment. Thank you **Dr. Stockton** for an informative presentation about a serious disease.




