Ed Rullman introduced a former member of our club, CAL FIRE Shasta Trinity Unit's Fire Chief **Mike Hebrard**. Mike was joined on stage by **Greg McFadden**, Battalion Chief at Cal Fire, and **Cullen Kreider**, Deputy Fire Chief of the Redding Fire Department.

The three firefighters shared their perspective of the Carr Fire over the last couple of weeks. They were able to show some terrifying images and videos of the raging fire and fire tornado that hit west Redding. As of today the fire was at 177,000 acres and only 48% contained.

Mike showed the club a couple of illustrations to try and explain the science behind the fire tornado (left and below). A combination of issues helped add to the conditions that broght about this terrible fire including over five years of drought in northern California, record grass crop rates, heavy winds, and the location of the fire itself.

You can see from the illustrations that the wind flow both outside of and caused by the fires all contributed to make the perfect fire storm, so to speak.

There were several questions from the crowd regarding information and rumors, some of them negative and asking for clarification. All three speakers stressed the importance of checking information heard through the media and online with verifiable sources like Cal Fire's website. They explained that

there is a lot of information about this terrible fire circulating right now and some of it is simply inaccurate.

While the fight with the Carr Fire is not yet over, the men and women working hard to battle the flames have shown themselves to be true heroes. The Rotary Club of Redding thanks you!




This Week's Meeting

Craft Talk

Robin Adams gave his Craft Talk at today's meeting. Rob is the Superintendent of Redding Elementary School District and Shasta Elementary School District. He is a Redding Native whose family roots go back a long time in Redding's history. He started out attending Redding schools, graduated high school in Redding, and had his first career in Redding. Rob eventually found a love for working with kids and went back to school at Chico State for his Bachelor's and Master's degrees. In recanting the story of his childhood he "name dropped" several favorite Redding businesses that made the crowd cheer for their memory.

Rob thanked the club for all they have done and are now doing for the Redding community. "Thank you Rotary for the service that you do [in our community], you helped build me," said Rob.

He finished his craft talk by giving a brief update on the situation of Shasta, Igo, and Redding elementary schools. Igo school is open; they're currently cleaning it out and the school year will start on time. The school has talked to every family of students at Shasta Elementary. Of the 140 students enrolled there about 120 are still living in the area. About 20 families form the school have lost their homes. That school will be relocated to the Igo campus until Shasta Elementary is repaired and fit to re-open. Rob was hopeful that might take about six months.

There was no damage to the Redding elementary schools. They're being professionally cleaned inside and out for smoke and ash, and all Redding schools are scheduled to start on time.




