The Rotary Club of Redding Management Report

BACKGROUND:

The Finance Committee recommended, and the Board approved, a spending policy for

the Foundation. The adopted spending policy for each year is 3 to 7% of the total balance in the Morgan Stanley account, determined as of 12/31 of the prior year. The Finance Committee meets to ascertain and recommend an amount for the upcoming budget year. The policy also notes that the balance in the account should not go below the amount of \$500,000.

For Rotary year 2018-2019 the Finance Committee recommended, and the Board agreed, an allocation of \$33,000 (5% of the Morgan Stanley account) toward the Club budget.

Liabilities of the Foundation (35,371)

Less amount already budgeted for year - as recommended by Finance Committee and adopted by the Board of Directors (33,000)

CARR Fire amount for current year approved by the Board (50,000)


