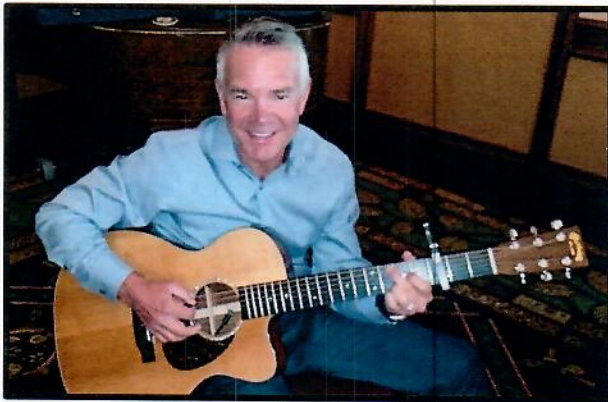

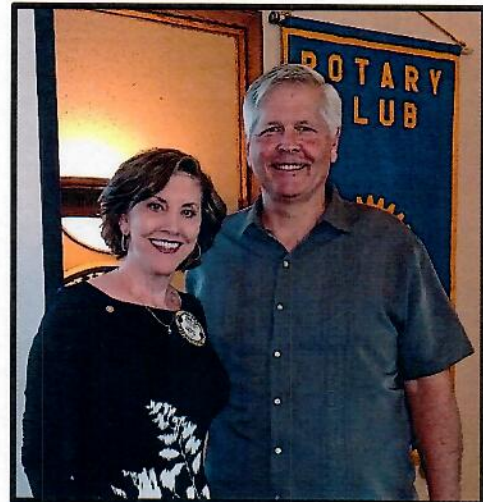


Rick Hill entertained us

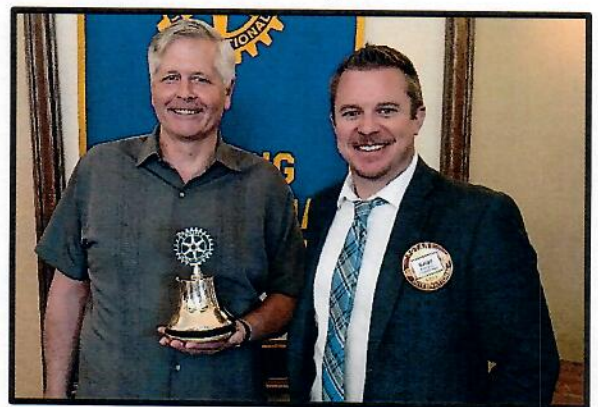

Mike Mangas got a new truck worth \$100 to the club. Thanks, **Mike**.

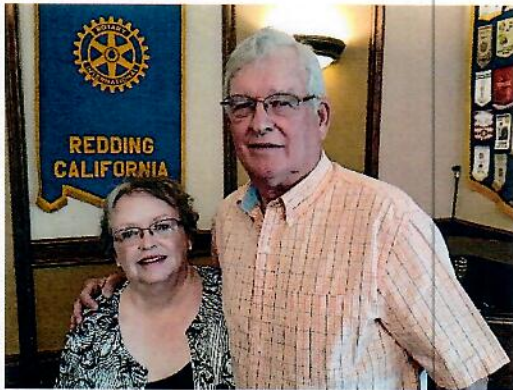
Bill Speer was in a golf tournament in Almanor and is expecting a new baby. Congratulations and thanks for the \$100 to the club and \$100 to your Shan.

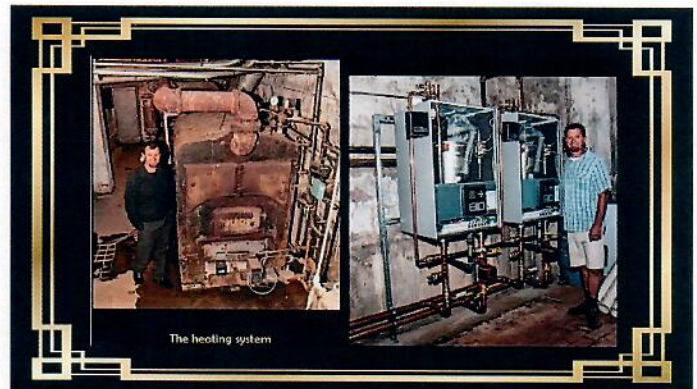

A great deal of credit goes to the Red Bluff community for developing such a great site. Good program.



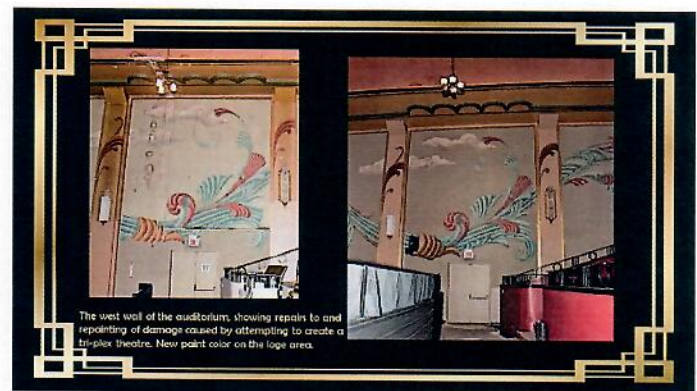
