

Randy Smith is asking for volunteers to help plant California poppies along the North







The State Theater was a movie theater built in 1946. Over the years it had become run down and was purchased in 2000 for \$500,000 by a 501.c3 called the State Theater for The Arts, (STFTA). Due to a great deal of community and Northstate support, it was paid off in two years.


