Program: Cindy Fisher introduced Paul Kjos, the Shasta County Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights & Measurers. informed the Club that there were approximately \$84 million in agricultural products grown in Shasta County last year. Most of those products were exported out of the area, with strawberries and walnuts being important commodities. Last July, the Shasta County Department of Agriculture trapped an oriental fruit fly in Shasta County for the first time. This is a very serious pest that can cause extreme damage to a wide range of agriculture. The Department is continuing to monitor the situation. If more flies are trapped, then steps will be taken to eradicate the fly. There may also be a need to impose a quarantine on the movement of agricultural products outside of the County. If that occurs, there could be a significant impact on the agricultural economy in Shasta County. Paul recommended that people not bring in fruit from out of the area and to also allow his Department to place traps on property when asked to do so. Thank you **Paul** for informing the Club about a significant pest that could have a serious adverse impact on Shasta County.
