- My Event module for events



Stocking planned for Mt. Shasta Rotary trophy trout program

Your editor thought this program from the Mt. Shasta Rotary Club would be of interest. It is good to know what the clubs in our area are doing. The article is from the District website and reads as follows.

The pay-off for the Mt. Shasta Rotary trout pens is a new trophy trout program at Lake Siskiyou, with a rearing facility for trophy sized rainbow trout.

Department of Fish and Wildlife delivered rainbow trout ready to be stocked Friday, December 7th.

Rotary Project Manager Tom Stienstra described the new facility as the best of its kind in the nation.



Rotary planned, financed, and constructed a dock structure with three pens at Lake Siskiyou for a pen-rearing program for trophy-sized rainbow trout. The Department of Fish and Wildlife projects the trout could range from 3 to 5 pounds when ready next spring.

Volunteers built the pens at Lake Siskiyou and then installed them in a cove neighboring the marina facility.

A press release described the process as follows: Each fall, when the water temperatures cool, the DFW will stock the pens with rainbow trout. Over the winter, solar-charged, battery– powered feeders will automatically feed the fish, which can grow an inch per month. In the spring, most likely early May, the large fish are released and quickly become naturalized to their habitat. They then take on the characteristics of wild fish. The trout are "triploids," that is, they cannot breed, and in turn, grow faster and fight harder.

Mt. Shasta Rotary's hope is "to commemorate the release with a youth fishing tournament, and the goal is to inspire increased outdoor participation with parents and their children.

Mt. Shasta Rotary has formed partnerships with the DFW and the Siskiyou County Board of Supervisors and received support from Kokanee Power, Sousa Ready Mix, Campbell Global, Lake Siskiyou Marina and private foundations.

Mt. Shasta Rotary sees the final results as:

The finest trout pen facility of any lake in America.

New opportunities for youth, families.

A template for how to provide big fish for any cold-water lake in the nation.

A program that is sustainable into the future.




