Shasta Regional Community Foundation & Carr Fire



Kerry Caranci (left), CEO of Shasta Regional Community Foundation, and Captain **Tim Danielson** (right), Salvation Army, shared with the club their experiences with the recent Carr Fire. They began by explaining their participation in the Volunteer Organizations Active in Disasters (VOAD). Shasta/Tehama has a VOAD group that includes local first responders (fire, police, and medical) as well as non-profit organizations that assist in disaster relief (Red Cross, United Way, Salvation Army, etc.). The Shasta/Tehama local VOAD group had been practicing for an emergency such as the Carr Fire under the late



Redding Fire Chief Gerry Gray. That practice gave them the cooperation and coordination needed to help with the relief efforts when the Carr Fire struck the Redding area last July.

Salvation Army is doing what's known as "Middle Term" recovery, doing things like installing utility polls and providing water to properties to allow owners to return to their homes/property to start to rebuild. Aside from the immediate needs that were evident in July, they're finding that there are unanticipated needs of the community that must be met as the months and eventually years go by after the Carr Fire. Some of those needs will be met by the over \$4 Million raised by Shasta Regional Community Foundation for Carr Fire victims.

Kerry explained that much of those funds raised are being held for future needs, although some grants have already been given out. Tim furthered that FEMA has told the VOAD group there is a certain amount off money they'll need to raise to offset non-insured or under-insured home owners, and for the 1,100 homes that burnt in the Carr Fire that number is \$15 Million. We have a long way to go! Tim shared that our local recovery efforts are currently about 8-months ahead of where Santa Rosa was at this time because the, "organizations have locked arms and are moving forward as one to make sure that our community recovers and that's phenomenal!"
