

**President Greg** introduced our club member, **Jennifer Finnegan**, who is the Executive Director of the Lassen Park Foundation. The Foundation has a partnership with Lassen Volcanic National Park to provide the Youth Camping Program. This program is designed to encourage youth group camping at the park. The program started in 1996 and serves over 500 kids per year. To bolster the camping experience, there are 140 Ranger led programs available.

The camp is housed at the Volcano Adventure Camp in the Park. It is 4 miles from Manzanita and has tent cabins and bunks. There are ten Tent Cabins and 80 bunk cots.

Why would you want to take your youth group? Remember how much fun you had when going camping when you were a kid. Camping is fun! No cell phone service—escape technology for a while. Kids have opportunities for team building, learning about the outdoors and being taught by experts.

The Youth Camping Program is available from June to September depending on the weather, ie snow. Application deadline has been extended until May 3<sup>rd</sup>. **Now is the time to apply. When is the last time someone paid you to go camping? \$1000 grants are available** to Youth Groups that qualify as a 501c3. Very few local groups ever apply. You might want to look into this. It's a great opportunity for local youth groups.




