Program: Greg Balkovek introduced Elizabeth Hadley. Elizabeth is the Acting Area Manager for the Northern California Area Office of the federal Bureau of Reclamation. Her office oversees nine dams including Shasta Dam, six power plants that generate 78% of the Central Valley Project's power, and manages roughly 200 water contracts. The Bureau of Reclamation is the second largest producer of hydroelectric power in the nation. Its mission is to manage, develop, and protect water and related resources in an environmentally and economically sound manner in the interest of the American public. For example, Shasta Dam is not only used for hydroelectric power, but also for flood control and maintaining cooler water temperatures in the Sacramento River which helps to maintain fish populations. Thank you Elizabeth for sharing with the Club the importance of the waterworks administered by the Bureau of Reclamation.
