

Today's Program: Children's Legacy Center

Stephanie Bridget introduced our speakers for today, Senior Deputy District Attorney Sarah Murphy, and Kimberly Johnson, CEO of the Children's Legacy Center. Sarah and Kimberly explained how the Center is a local, grassroots effort responding to the devastating issue of child abuse in our region.

As a prosecutor for child abuse cases, Sarah painted a picture of how pervasive this problem is in our county. In 2018 alone there were 162 child abuse prosecutions in Shasta county, and almost 650 substantiated cases reported by Health and Human Services, which is more than double the State of California average. She explained that being a cycle of abuse, the solution to this problem lies in better serving the victims so they don't grow up to be offenders themselves.

The Children's Legacy Center, a work in progress, follows a model created more than 30 years ago in Huntsville, AL. The vision is to co-locate the various agencies and resources involved in serving these victims so that, among other benefits, the retelling of their abuse can be kept to a minimum. Their goal: Any child in Shasta County who is sexually or physically abused, witnesses a physical or violent crime, is severely neglected or trafficked will come to the Children's Legacy Center to receive their forensic interview, non-acute medical exam, advocacy support, housing if needed and therapy services.




