Extreme Escape Redding

An Escape Room is defined as, "a fully immersive real-life adventure game in which players solve a series of puzzles using clues, hints and strategy to complete the objectives at hand. Small groups of participants are given a set time limit to unveil the secret plot which is hidden within the rooms in order to find a way out of the actual chamber. Games are set in a variety of fictional locations such as prison cells, dungeons and space stations, and are popular as team building exercises".

That's what Extreme Escape Redding provides, a variety of Escape Rooms with rotating themes an puzzles. But that's not ALL Extreme Escape Redding does.

Escape rooms are known for their team building effectiveness. The small

teams that participate in the rooms have to work together to make it out of the room within the time limit set. This encourages behaviors such as: communication, working under pressure, time management, delegating tasks, strategy coordinating, asking for help, and learning communication styles. These are qualities many of us could stand to develop further, and an escape room is a really fun way to do just that!

Owners Aaron & Jessica Souza own several businesses in Redding but confessed they have a great time running Extreme Escape Redding. The success of Extreme Escape has allowed them to put "Service Above Self" and give back to our local community in many ways. In the years since it opened, the Souza's have supported projects such as: Adopt a Family, Wounded Warrior Project, group home projects, Gifted Education programs, Carr Fire recovery, and countless donations to many local charities.




