Shan Fellowship

In the September 2019 issue of the Spillway, we published an article which gave some history to the Shan Fellowship. We're thankful to John Dunlap for taking time to put that article together. To bring you some additional information on this topic, in April of 2017 President Ray Stewart and Club Business Manager Kim Christofferson authored a document to give clarity to the specifics of the Shan Award. This document was approved by the Rotary Club of Redding/Rotary Club of Redding Charitable Foundation Board of Directors on April 11, 2017. Here are some excerpts from that document:

Shan Fellow and Multiple Shan Fellow: When a member has donated a cumulative \$1,000 total to the Rotary Club of Redding Charitable Foundation (RCRCF) – including any combination of giving to the Annual Fund and/or the Permanent Fund – and they have completed their first Paul Harris Fellowship, the member is given an acknowledgement from the RCRCF called the Shan Fellowship. When additional cumulative \$1,000 contributions are given, the member is acknowledged again by RCRCF as a Multiple Shan Fellow for every \$1,000 given.

Items that count toward Shan Fellowship accrual include all donations given to either the Annual Fund (unrestricted) or the Permanent Fund (Endowment) of The Rotary Club of Redding Charitable Foundation. The \$100 designated to the Foundation from Club Annual dues does not accrue toward any Shan Fellowship. Only donations to the Foundation accrue as noted in the annual pledge form.

The intended use of the word “Shan” is to acknowledge an individual’s giving to the Rotary Club of Redding Charitable Foundation. The word “Shan” should be limited in use only to describe the “honor” or “pin” known as the Shan Fellowship or Multiple Shan Fellowship. It is inappropriate to use the word “Shan” to describe the Club Endowment or Foundation Funds.

Here's some additional information from John Mathena:

The Multiple recognition is given only once when the member has contributed \$2000 and the members name is included in the Multiple List only which is placed on the lunch table during Shan Month. They do get a Multiple Shan pen which different than the first pen.

When the member request that his contribution go towards their Shan that contribution goes to the foundations Endowment Fund. It is the same as when a member says they will contribute to their Paul Harris it goes it goes to the Rotary Foundation not Paul Harris. If a member has some confusion about the award they can contact the Chairman.

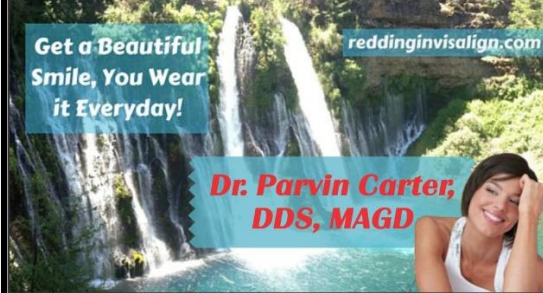
