Fire Chief Bret Gouvea. They spoke on several issues concerning what happened during the Carr fire and what steps are being taken to make Redding more fire safe.

Both agencies have had an increase in funding which will add additional personnel. Yea!

We are all pretty familiar with the idea of 100 feet of defensible space around your home. A new concept of Home Ignition Zones and factors is something that hasn't been talked about as much.

Some suggestions were no landscaping bark around your house. No wood fences connected to your

house. Have at least five feet of noncombustible fence material connection to your house. Keep bushes and plants next to your house low so fire can't burn the bushes and get into your attic or crawl space. They pointed out that most of the homes burned in Redding during the Carr fire were ignited by one of the three above factors.

They mentioned several mitigation programs including herds of goats to clear underbrush.

They spoke at length about the new Shield Training Center that is being built at Shasta College. This is an idea that has been developed over the twenty years. It is a result of public safety entities in Shasta, Trinity, and Tehama working together to provide a facility to do initial and ongoing training to public safety members. "The goal is to reduce, if not eliminate, the need to send employees away for training as the training will now be offered locally." It will be open soon and will be a great asset to the Northstate area.



It was obvious how much respect each of the Chiefs had for each other and each other's departments. It is very gratifying to see such cooperation as we all benefit when that is present.




