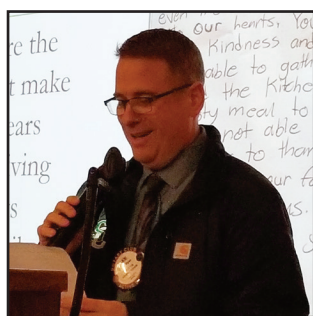
Today's Introductions
