Despite a combined age over 156 years, two Rotarians accomplished the following in three hours this morning: sprayed a half acre of climax Himalayan blackberry permeated with common poke weed; liberated four large trees from circumferential English ivy growing to a height beyond forty feet; felled and dismembered eight invasive Chinese tallow trees (largest DBH> 6"); readied a salvageable Oregon ash for "come-along removal" of a snow storm broken top, chainsawed another half acre of Spanish broom which was stump treated, hauled, piled and readied for disposal, perhaps this week end; toured the entire 5R Project Central Section and generally had a good time in the wilds of middle Redding along the lovely and lonely Sacramento River.

Two ounces of Rotary Tahoe 3A and 8 oz. of Rotary Polaris were used to accomplish proper and permitted treatment of invasive species. Many thanks to Dee Potter who tirelessly used his extensive ranch and resort experience to accomplish a great deal in a limited amount of time. Rotarian Jim Grant would be proud of his disciples' understanding that incremental achievement is often the only way large tasks are accomplished. Aside the effort stained through Dee's shirt, the mostly non native plant morass behind Dee, thence Wood Duck Slough and sixty yards to the River shows how badly this project is needed so that Riverview can be safe, restored and true to its name.
