
## Today's Introductions

### **Today's Program - NVCSS Carr Fire Relief**

**Kathy Malain** introduced today's speaker, Matthew Gile, Program Manager of the Disaster Case Management team with Northern Valley Catholic Social Services (NVCSS). He was joined by several NVCSS team members including: Lou Hecker, Construction Analyst; Disaster Case Managers Kayla Buckner, Matt Crum, Guy Malain, Caroline Miles, and Henry Williams; **PP Kathy Anderson**, Volunteer Disaster Case Manager for the first year of the program Matthew presented statistics on the success of the program so far.

He emphasized that Carr Fire recovery is going to be a long process and that we're currently in an interim phase that could last up to 10 years. Recovery is a long process and NVCSS is making sure that assistance will be around for those that need it in the years to come.

NVCSS's recovery efforts began as a volunteer team of ten (10) people affectionately known as the Dream Team. In May 2019 they were awarded a FEMA contract for Disaster Case Managemet Program. Through January of this year that volunteer team has provided 37.5 forty-hour-weeks, and helped their clients

receive about \$1.5M in recovery services. Matthew recognized **PP Kathy Anderson** as being part of that team.

The FEMA funded contract has to date resulted 183 clients, 32 homes approved for funding, and about \$3.7M in recovery resources. Matthew says there's still a long way to go until work is done, but they've made a lot of progress.

Matthew closed by sharing a few stories of families that were helped by NVCSS and received funding provided by the Rotary Club of Redding's Carr Fire Relief Fund. Thank you to Matthew and his team for sharing with us this week!
