# The City of Redding Downtown Update



The October 8th program featured Steve Bade and the City of Redding "Downtown Update." Steve has been in Redding for 22 years. Steve has been involved with community development and housing projects. Now he is the driving force behind the revitalization of downtown Redding. Steve is very excited to see the revitalization efforts coming to realization.

Included is a four-story mixed building structure that will have housing on floors 2-4, with commercial businesses on the first floor. There will be 22,000 square feet of commercial space. There will be 82 residential units above the commercial area. There will also be an underground parking facility with 95 parking spaces. The completion date is projected to be November 15th, 2020.

Part of the downtown development is a steam powered whistle. We have heard the Gerlinger whistle blow at 5:00 p.m. for years. The new steam whistle is an exciting feature of the development.

Following this article will be a number of pictures showing the progress of the development and some pictures with information about the development. A big question brought by a number of people is where will the parking be and will there be enough parking. The answer is there will be 100 more parking spaces than there are today. In addition to the parking space increase there are several shuttles operating now from a number of places and several routes. The shuttles are being piloted by Redding Police Department cadets.

To help with transportation, a number of bike routes are being developed connecting many of the existing trails and areas within the city.










**Steam Whistle Schematic** 























President Jake closes the meeting with an actual Rotary Bell (amazing). He rewards Steve Bade with the customary Redding Rotary baseball (Stronger Together).






