PP Amelia reminded us that this is World Polio Month. She is looking for someone to be known as the polio warrior. This person will be doing all things related to polio for our club.

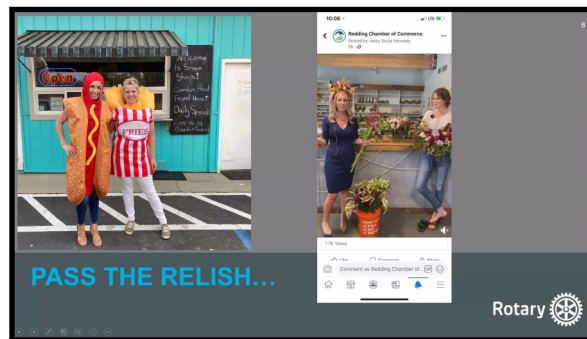

The City of Redding Downtown Update



The October 8th program featured Steve Bade and the City of Redding “Downtown Update.” Steve has been in Redding for 22 years. Steve has been involved with community development and housing projects. Now he is the driving force behind the revitalization of downtown Redding. Steve is very excited to see the revitalization efforts coming to realization.

Included is a four-story mixed building structure that will have housing on floors 2-4, with commercial businesses on the first floor. There will be 22,000 square feet of commercial space. There will be 82 residential units above the commercial area. There will also be an underground parking facility with 95 parking spaces. The completion date is projected to be November 15th, 2020.

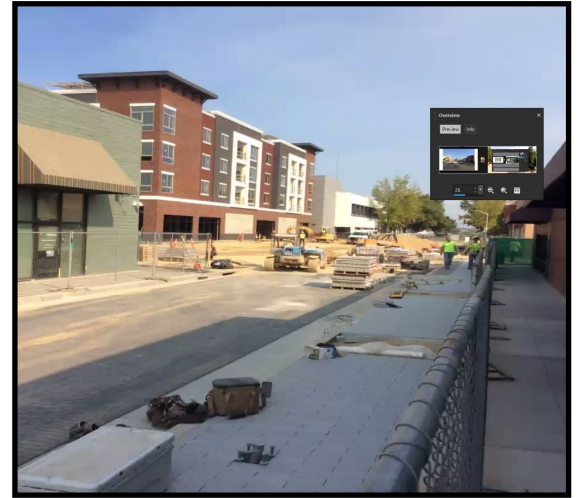
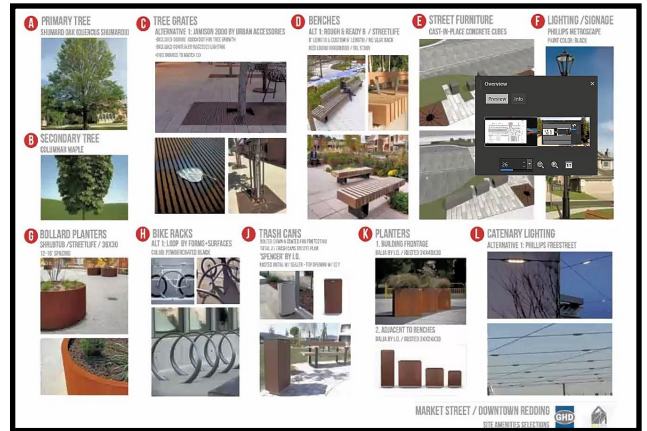
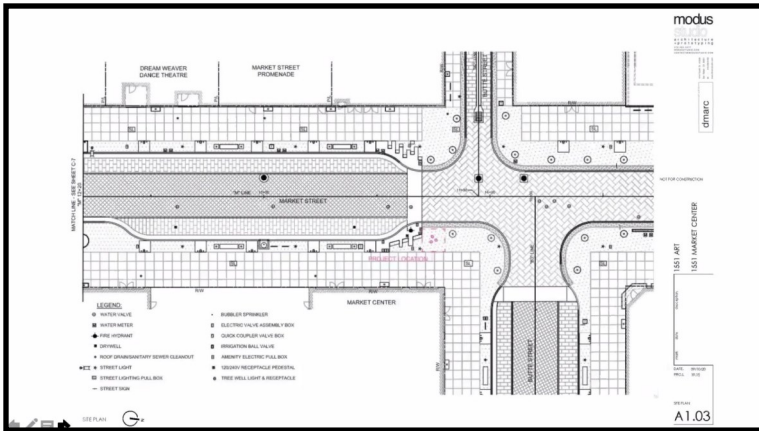

To help with transportation, a number of bike routes are being developed connecting many of the existing trails and areas within the city.

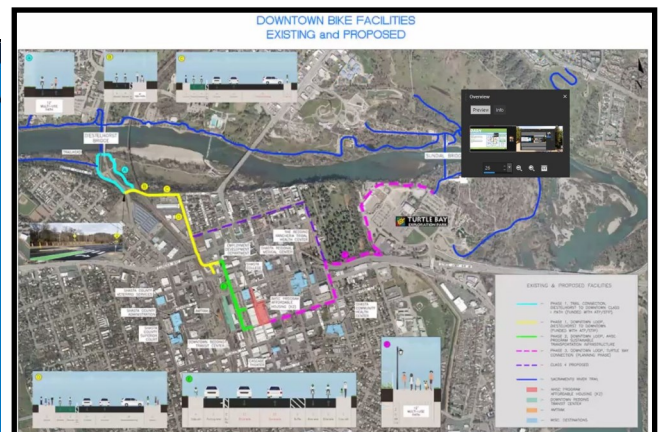
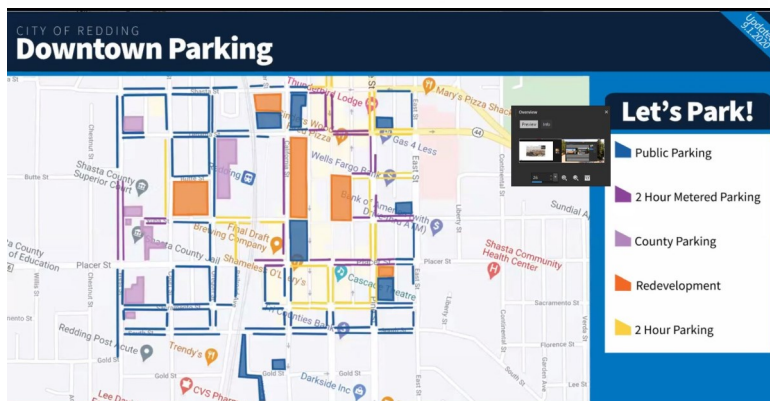
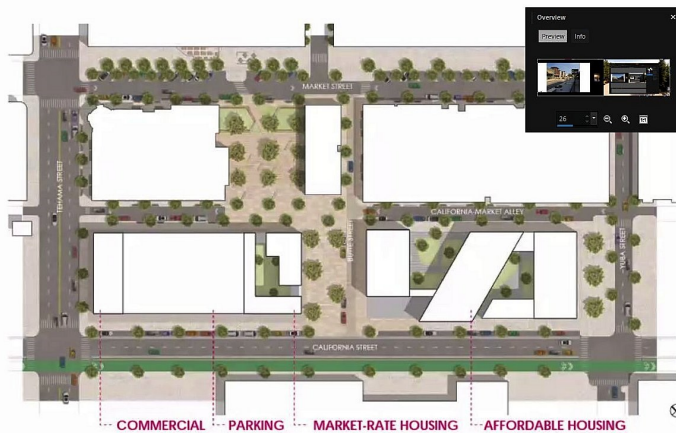
