Before the meeting, **Jennifer Finnegan** entertained us with her beautiful piano playing. Thanks, **Jennifer**. Click on the picture to hear the music.



Program: Rick Plummer introduced the Club's own Courtney McElvain, who is a financial advisor



As for 2021, there are several positive indicators. The International Monetary Fund estimates that global gross domestic procduct will climb 5.2%. Also, according to Capital Group research, in 2020, we saw the fastest recovery in history. The market has the potential to go up in 2021 as the world turns the corner on recovering from COVID-19. However, there are always risks that cannot be avoided. **Courtney** also explained how fixed income investments (like savings accounts) may be best used as insurance to protect against equity investments that may be more volatile. 
