Before the meeting, **Rick Hill** entertained us with his skilled guitar playing. Thanks, **Rick**.

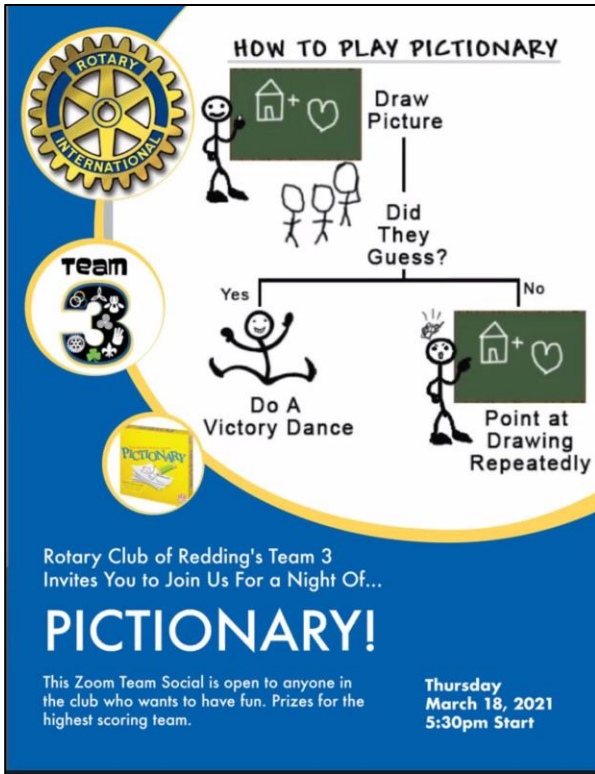
