


Good News Rescue Mission Update

Rick shared a recording he made a few years ago of his version of *California Dreaming*




Pictionary!

Today's Program - Good News Rescue Mission

To introduce today's program, **Mike Mangas** made mention of our speakers interest in hot, hot, hot peppers: **Jonathan Anderson**, Executive Director of the Good News Rescue Mission.

In this role for seven years, **Jonathan** gave us a "year in review" update on the Mission.

The COVID pandemic was clearly the biggest challenge for the Mission this past year resulting in devastating impacts. Jonathan shared that although homeless populations in general have been among the least impacted by COVID, homeless *shelters* have been among the worst. The Mission worked closely with the County to implement precautionary changes, but with 9 separate buildings spread across 3 city blocks, the task was monumental.



Over the summer, only a few people tested positive for COVID with quick recoveries. However, by mid Fall, there was a rapid increase in cases and a worst case scenario became a realty. With a service population of around 1,600, there was great relief in having a number of these individuals housed in hotels thanks to Project Room Key. In spite of the difficulties, over 145,000 meals were served at the Mission and over 20,000 meals were provided to the those being hosed by Project Room Key.

At the low point of this outbreak, during a single week, 86% of the staff tested positive for COVID. Mission staff was reduced from 36 full time workers to only 4. During this time, 100% of their housed recovery students tested positive with about 1/2 of their other guests testing positive. As **Jonathan** put it, "it was a nightmare" - the first time in the history of the Mission it almost had to close down.

Jonathan mentioned that there were many, many volunteers for the community, including our Rotary Club, who turned out to serve the Mission. By name, a huge thanks was given to Lee & Judy Salter for their help.

Through this experience **Jonathan** challenges all of us to carry a greater sense of compassion & sensitivity for humanity and community as a whole.

A Very Special Birthday




