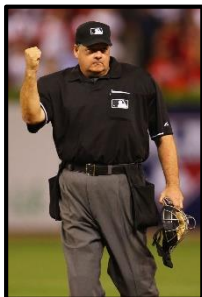
We lined up, got our food

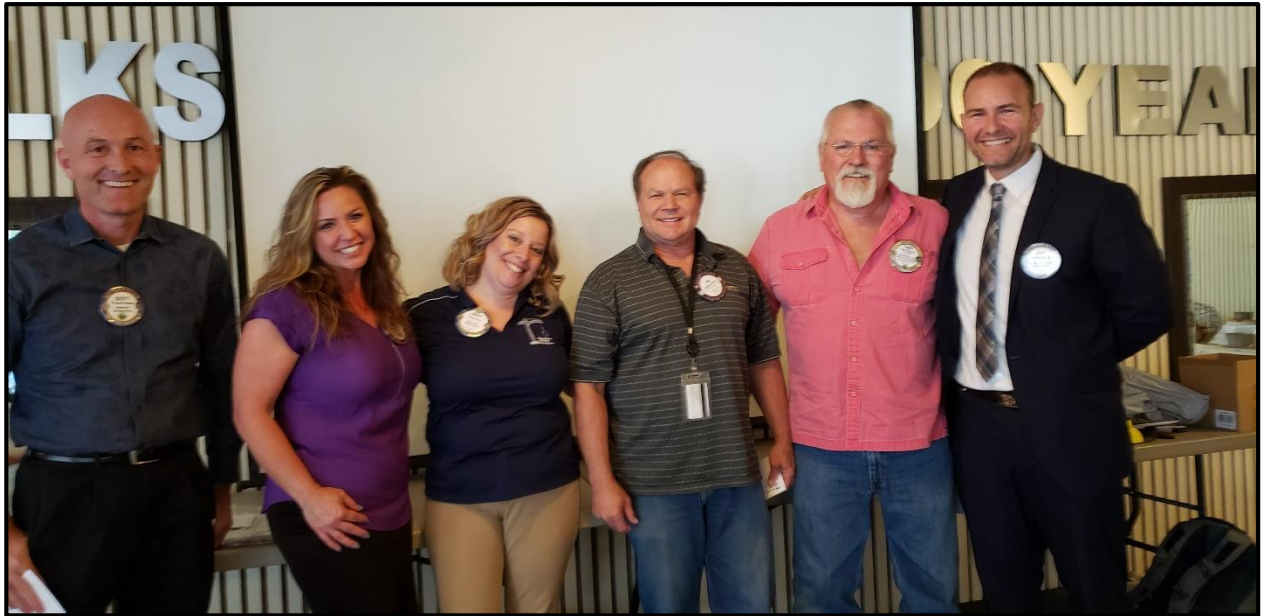
