Dear friends,

It's July 1st! I am honored, excited and truly inspired by all of you as we begin this new year of Rotary in District 5160. My journey to becoming your District Governor has been filled with numerous wonderful experiences. I'm sure you have many of your own in your Rotary career. I am reminded of a quote by a Past President of Rotary International, Sir Clem Renouf, "Rotary takes ordinary men and women and gives them extraordinary opportunities to do more with their lives than they ever dreamed possible."

You collected food for local food banks, you made masks for essential workers and you assisted in COVID vaccine events. I doubt that any of us imagined the extraordinary opportunities in which we found to serve last year.

A Rotary Club is a collection of relationships, District 5160 is a collection of relationships and Rotary International is a collection of relationships – all built on friendships and a common set of values. In the past year, we gave up handshakes and hugs, but we didn't give up our core values. We will have questions and decisions to make as our Rotary Clubs create a new normal this year. 


