The program at the recent Redding Rotary meeting was brought to us by Ryan Spitz. California Adventure Academy is an alternative to traditional grades K through 12. It is similar to home study only there is a school campus with teachers and people influencing the students learning.

The Academy launched in September, 2020. Presently there are just over 200 students enrolled. The effects of the Carr fire and Covid 19 delayed the opening but as of now all is full speed ahead. The program offers youth focus programs. Early on students are taught patience, attentiveness, self control, unity, courage, respect, grit, gratitude, trustworthiness and kindness. I am sure the "Golden Rule" is in there somewhere. As the student moves from grade to grade they learn many subjects in the "Creative Program" and eventually to the "Adventure Program." The subjects can be seen in the images that will follow on the next pages.

American society has changed over the years with both the mother and father having careers. This undoubtedly has had an affect on children. Mom and Dad are not at home and the kids simply miss some things. This is no ones fault, it is just a fact. The California Adventure Academy has a goal of filling that void. 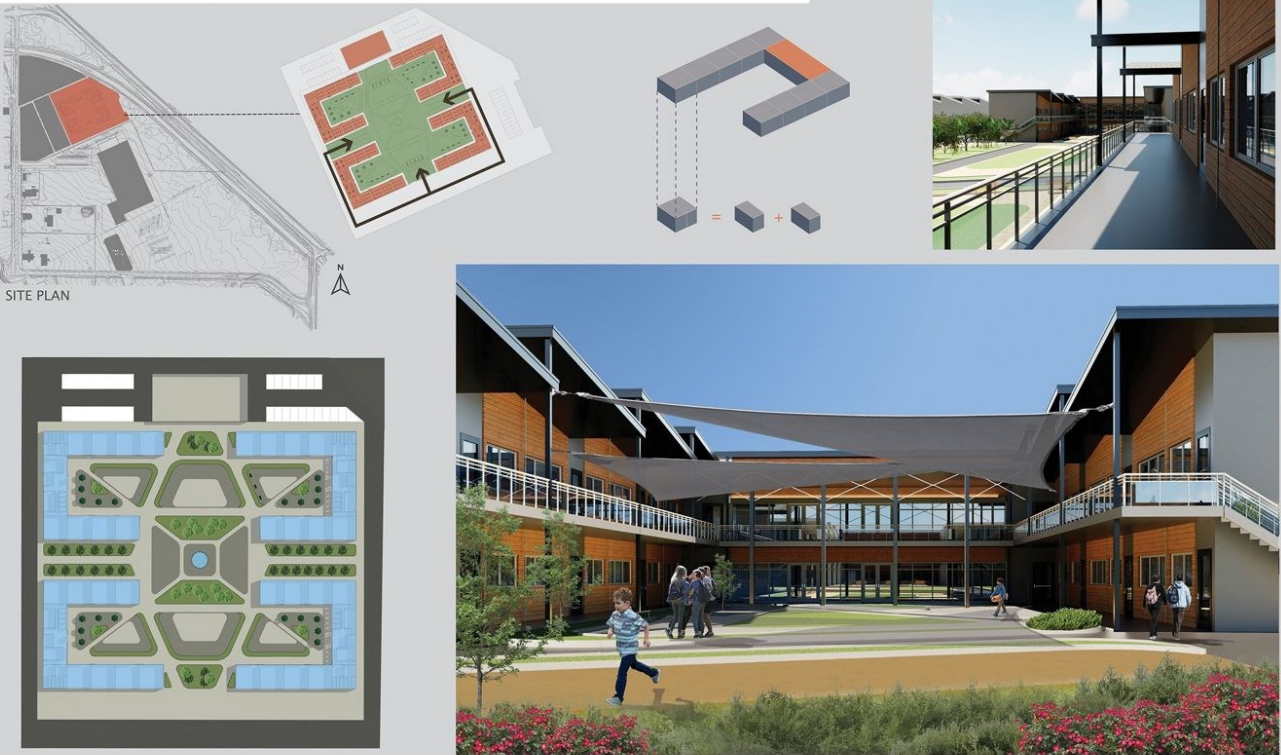

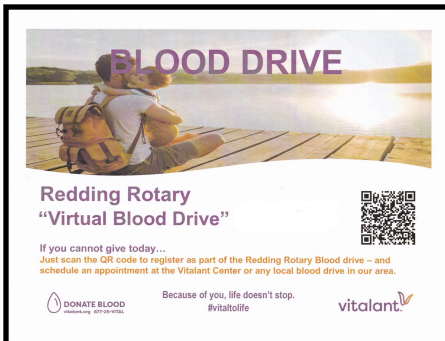

SITE PLAN AND MODULAR CONFIGURATION

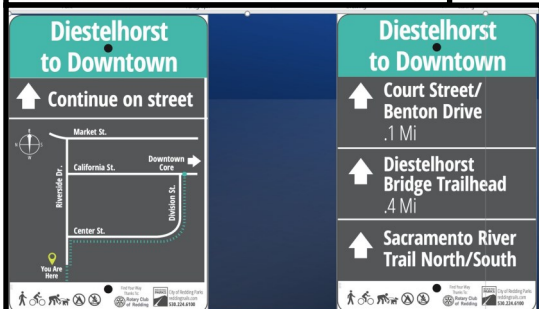
President Joe's Recognitions

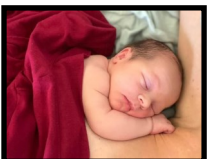
No doubt our president was well aware of the no show. With the buck stops here attitude our president donated \$100.00 to the club.
