### Today's Program - Children's Legacy Center

**Karen Karnatz** introduced today's speaker, **Kimberly Johnson**, Executive Director & Founder of the Children's Legacy Center.



A quick statement of why the Center exists:

Any child in our region who is sexually or physically abused, witnesses a physical or violent crime, is severely neglected or trafficked will come to the Children's Legacy Center to receive their forensic interview, non-acute medical exam, advocacy support, housing if needed and therapy services.

**Kimberly** gave us an update from her previous presentation to our club from about two years ago. Some important take-aways:

- **New Building** the Center now has a new-to-them facility on the corner of Liberty Street & Shasta Street downtown. Kimberly gave us a virtual tour of the inside showing the comfortable, homey interior design to help put those they serve at ease. This location puts them with one mile of all the agencies they work with, the only exception being the Anderson Police Department.
- **Finances** an import point made was the amount of money being brought into our community from outside sources to fund their building project and other expenses. Over 74% of the building project was funded by State and Federal sources.
