## Today's Program - Catalyst Mentoring

Wendy Dickens introduced our speaker for the day, Jenna Berry. Jenna is the Executive Director of Catalyst Mentoring, a non proft based here in Redding who's vision is to "... invest in our city's youth to invest in our city's future through the power of mentoring". Our own Rotary Club of Redding has been an active supporter of this organization, most notably with their recent Life Skills Academy.

**Jenna** spoke about the incredible impact that is being brought about in our community through the efforts of ordinary citizens. Catalyst Mentoring provides in-house training for it's volunteers who then commit to spending just one hour per week with a student. The need is simple for these students: have a healthy adult show up consistently and show interest in what interests them.

Some exciting news that **Jenna** shared is that her organization has received a grant from the Shatsa County Office of Education (SCOE) to bring their mentoring model to 30 campuses across the County. This, coupled with a new building they'll move into in October, a new relationship with Dunamis Wellness Center, and additional staff coming




