

He was very informative and entertaining. Thanks, Lou for giving us an alternative to the grid.



A little bit on geodesic domes gleaned from the internet.

Geodesic domes are hemispherical thin-shell structures based on a geodesic polyhedron. The triangular elements of the dome are structurally rigid and distribute the structural stress throughout the structure, making geodesic domes able to withstand very heavy loads for their size. They are energy

efficient. Geodesic domes promote more efficient air circulation and keep temperatures even throughout the structure.


