
Announcements

The Business of the Bike Path

Featured speakers included right Chuck Aukland, Director of City of Redding Public Works.

Featured at the meeting was the Diestelhorst Downtown Bike Path and the effects it has on the Redding community. It is a loop trail linking the Diestelhorst bridge to downtown Redding. Chuck Aukland was the first to speak. The project kicked off in 2015 and was completely funded now by grants. The cost was about five million dollars. During the question and answer portion Chuck was asked why so much money. His answer was sidewalks and the engineering of the area was very expensive. Old walkways and structures needed to be removed and rebuilt. Bike lanes were put on many streets. To do this one needs heavy equipment. The goal was to have quality to last a long time.

Chuck said the goal of the project was to meet the needs of all users. Safety of the participants was another must have feature. He mentioned addressing the wants of the public several times.

Angie talked about the effect the trail has on her business. A bike trail means you need bikes. Angie and Mitch have just what you need. She mentioned several events start at the Chain Gang location and do the loop. Such events bring the community together. She also mentioned, with the construction of the trail, the area has become much safer to travel. This is a win win for all.

Last to speak was Sam. The building that houses Theory Coffee Roaster is historical. The building was constructed around the original brick. The bike path passes right in front of his business.

He mentioned bringing the community together. Folk come in on a Saturday for a coffee and a bike ride.

The grand opening of the bike path was July 15th 2021.


