Greg has always recommended when a door of opportunity opens, take it. Greg gave \$100.00 to the club.


Past President Jeff Avery's Encounter

The Rotary Club of Redding recognized 40 area high school students who have volunteered for military service following graduation this June as part of the Rotary club's Ninth Annual Sentinel Send-Off luncheon. In a program prepared by Greg Balkovek and Tom Stovall with the assistance of Courtney McElvain and Todd Jones, and the Veteran's Committee, two special Memorial Day videos were presented. Each student was recognized and presented with a special certificate. Bagpipe music was provided by Bob and Mollie Skinner of the Jefferson Pipe Band.

Veteran's Committee members worked with high school staff and military recruiters to identify the recruits. Letters of invitation were prepared for each recruit, who could bring two additional guests. Twenty recruits and guests were able to attend the luncheon.

Balkovek said, "Each of the students has chosen a military path at this point in time. Some see it as a path to higher education, others for adventure. Some to find out who they are and where they want to go in life. They will travel to places they've only seen in the news or read about. Some will see and do things that will truly test their mettle. Others will find a career. All will grow and mature. The road they have chosen is not for everyone. Not everyone can or would travel this military road. All are volunteers."

The Recruits represented 10 area high schools in Shasta, Siskiyou and Tehama counties with the breakdown by service as follows: U.S. Air Force, 14, U.S. Army, 5, U.S. Marine Corps. 14, U.S. Coast Guard, 1, U.S. Navy, 5, U.S. Merchants Marine Academy, 1, and the U.S. Space Force, 1. Five military recruiters representing the armed services attended the luncheon.
