Fire Chief Jerrod Vanlandingham

Program: Wendy Dickens introduced City of Redding Fire Chief Jerrod Vanlandingham. Chief Vanlandingham gave the Club an overview of the City of Redding Fire Department. The City Fire Department consists of three divisions: Administration/Logistics, Operations, and Prevention. There are currently eight fire stations, with 87 firefighters in the stations, and 11 support In addition to responding to fires, the department also performs emergency medical services, addresses hazardous materials, performs technical rescues, and conducts fire prevention and investigation services. The Department also uses goats to engage in grazing and the resulting reduction of fire fuels. The Department receives over 16,000 calls annually, and approximately 60% of those calls are medically related. In 2021, there were over 600 fires in the City and every year fire season seems to get worse. The Department continues to work to improve its services, and appreciates all the support provided by the community. Thank you Chief Vanlandingham for the Fire Department's work in keeping our community safe!




