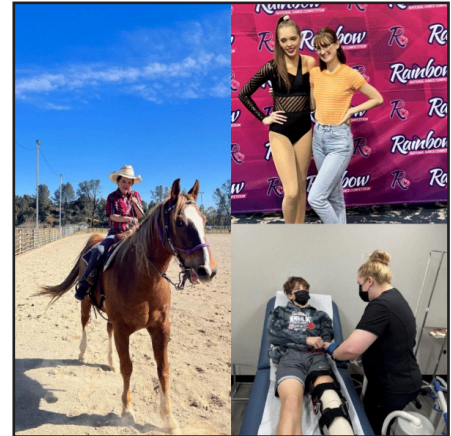
Recognitions

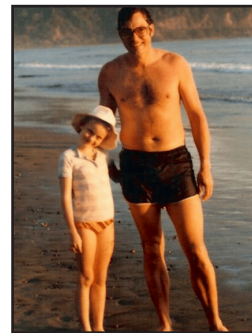
