

Program - Community Connect

Today, **Wendy Dickens** introduced our speaker, Redding Rotary's own **Judy Flores**, Shasta County Superintendent of Schools. **Judy** spoke on an initiative spearheaded by the Shasta County Office of Education (SCOE), Community Connect.

Community Connect is a collaboration between several area agencies and non-profits to improve the attendance of students K-12 in our county. The steps that each school is taking are:



- 1. As a school attendance team
 - Review attendance data & trends regularly
 - Determine which families to reach out to
- 2. Communicate with families & determine reasons for attendance challenges
- 3. Connect families to resources within the school's sphere of influence
- 4. Refer to Community Connect if barriers are beyond the school/district's sphere of influence

Once referred to Community Connect, the families are connected with appropriate organizations to bring the assistance and support they need. The current collaborative organizations are pictured to the right.

Some statistics of note regarding this effort's success during the 2020 - 2021 school year:

- 600 students were identified as needing assistance
- Community Connect was able to communicate with 75% of these
- Of this number, 41% of the students & families engaged in support services
- The most common linkage to communitybased resources were: basic needs, mental health, education, and behavior




