

PP Joe Ayer proudly announced his daughter has kicked off her career with her first teaching job, and









PP Greg Balkovek shared photos of his recent family reunion/vacation to Hawaii, Monterey and Michigan.

Program: Next Wendy Dickens introduced Michael Burke, a former member of our club and now the Executive Director of Pathways to Hope for Children. Michael explained that Pathways to Hope, formerly known as The Child Abuse Prevention Coordinating Council, was renamed to focus on a positive trajectory: the fostering and development of HOPE rather than focusing on the abuse. Shasta County has a problem: we suffer from some of the highest incidents of ACE's (Adverse Childhood Experiences) in the nation.



In the past this is where the presentation stopped, but today **Pathways** expands beyond the trauma to **Hope.** "Hope is the belief that the future will be better and you have the power to make it so." **Michael** went into depth about the **Science of Hope**: that in over 2000 published studies "hope is the single best predictor of well being compared to any other measures of trauma recovery"





So then if **Hope** is essential to trauma recovery, how do we create hope in the midst of a child's despair? **Goal setting**. "Goal setting is the cornerstone of **Hope**."

Pathways now has teen centers in Redding and Anderson. For more info go to hopeshasta.org.

The Simplicity of Hope Goal setting is the cornerstone of hope.

Pathways refers to the ability to identify routes toward goals and to find new routes (problem solve) around obstacles if necessary.

Agency (Willpower) is the ability to sustain motivation to move along these pathways.

Thanks for the fantastic Presentation, **Michael.** There is tremendous joy in changing lives.


