
Recognitions

Today's Program - RFD's CERT Program

Jerrod Vanlandingham introduced Redding Fire Department's (RFD) Deputy Fire Chief **Jay Sumerlin** who spoke about the department's soon-to-be-rolled-out Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Program.

Jay explained that the CERT Program will train and empower Redding citizens in the following skills:

- · Basic First Aid
- CPR
- Triage
- Light Rescue
- Fie Safety
- Defensible Space

The natural outcomes of this training, **Jay** explained, will lead to teamwork among those who are trained, and opportunities for leadership within the area of citizen emergency response efforts.

The history behind this type of program in the U.S. originated in Los Angeles when there became an awareness that city was under prepared for a large scale emergency. Visits by the LA organizers to Japan & Mexico City gave them a framework to develop curriculum and an organization that would lead to community risk reduction and operational preparedness.

With its roll out, Redding will become one of over 2,700 such programs in the U.S.





