1. Current Transcript: high school, college, or trade school transcript
2. Three (3) Letters of Recommendation: from counselors, employers and/or teachers
3. Financial Needs Response Essay: 300 words or less, explaining the financial need and impact a scholarship award in the amount of \$500 - \$5,000 would provide the applicant in attending or completing their educational/training goals.

Application Deadline: Wednesday, March 1st, 2023 | Incomplete Applications Not Accepted

A Scholarships are eligible for trade schools, colleges, or universities.



If a scholarship is awarded, payment of the scholarship will require additional documentation verifying proof of enrollment from a trade school, college or university. All documentation is due by June 15th following the award presentation.

Example:

The scholarship is awarded at a Rotary Luncheon presentation in the Spring of 2023. All documentation is due to the Gary Burks Memorial Scholarship Committee by June 15th or sooner. All funds will be disbursed by August 31st, 2023 for the Fall Semester, or earlier if proof of enrollment is received.
