PROGRAM: EARLY CHILDHOOD SERVICE



Today's program was brought to us by **Renée Menefee**, Executive Director, and **Kurt Swanson**, Operations Director, of Early Childhood Services (ECS). ECS is the largest department in the Shasta School District and oversees over 40 grants and contracts to serve and support young children, families, educators and other family serving organizations in our community. With eight divisions ranging from Health and Nutrition to Planning and Accountability, their mission is to support the development and education of young children in Shasta County. Early childhood support systems



can be fragmented and a challenge to access or even know they exist. This is what drives **Renée** and why she is so passionate about it.



Next, Operations Director **Kurt Swanson** took us on somewhat of a virtual tour of their new Early Childhood Education & Observation Center at 43 Hilltop Dr. ECS is the central access point to resources and support for young children and their families.

Funded by the "Alphabet Soup" state grant to the tune of \$8 million dollars and another \$3 million from Shasta County Office of Education, they expanded the original building from 7,000 to 21,000 square feet that includes a large meeting room, commercial kitchen, and an observation room that allows for more accurate child assessment by therapists and other professionals.

It was exciting to learn about this new chapter in the development of local systems to combat childhood poverty, missed education, malnutrition and other adverse childhood experiences. Thank to **Renée** and **Kurt** for taking the time to share with us today.


