



# **Program: "Share-the-Love!"**





# **Redding Rotary Supports Boy Scout Troop 37**

At its December meeting, the Rotary Board agreed to be the Chartering Organization of Boy Scout Troop 37 and earmarked **\$500** for the troop's support.

Redding Elks Lodge #1073 was the sponsor of the troop since its inception; however, at the direction of BPOE national, all lodges were directed to not renew their charters with local scouting organizations, much to the consternation of the lodges and, in particular, #1073.

Greg Balkovek, a member of both organizations and past scoutmaster for the troop, was made aware of the situation by Redding dentist Ron Zufall, the lodge's chartered representative, and former Scout District Executive Anna Pownell. Zufall's father was the founding scoutmaster of the troop.

Greg reached out to the lodge's exhalted ruler and found the lodge was not happy with the directive, but wanted to continue to house the troop's equipment and provide facilities for programs, meetings and gatherings. Additionally, the lodge wanted to engage the troop in service for which funding could be provided to the troop and scout summer camp expenses.

As the new Chartered Organization Representative (COR), Greg completed the paperwork, two hours of council volunteer training, two hours of federal child endangerment training and a background check. The charter was approved earlier this month.

Greg has met with the troop several times and is working with them on their program and enrollment. Troop 37 is the second Scouting organization sponsored by Redding Rotary. Cub Scout Pack 44 has been sponsored by the Redding Rotary for more than 70 years, the longest running Scouting sponsorship in the Shasta County.






