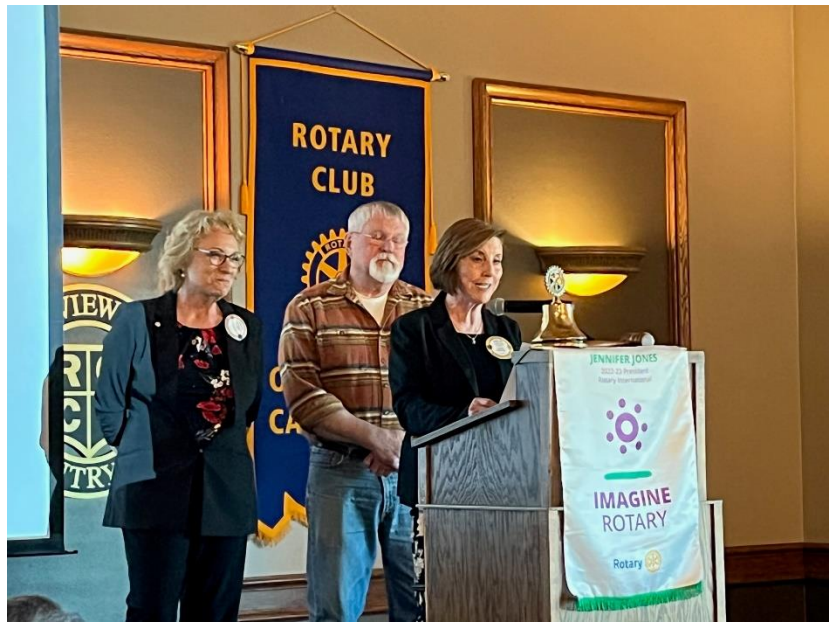
INDUCTIONS

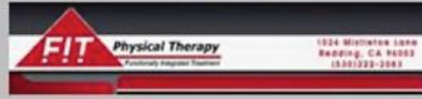
