## Today's Program: Leadership Redding

**Michelle Nystrom** introduced our speakers for today, Leadership Redding's Steering Committee Chair **Liz Crain**, and Vice Chair, **Brian Scarr**.

Leadership Redding was founded in 1985 as part of the Redding Chamber of Commerce under the leadership of our own **PP Lou Gerard**, but is now it's own 501 (c) (3) organization.

"The Leadership Redding Program is an awareness and educational opportunity which serves as a catalyst for individuals who seek participation in community decision-making at all levels in voluntary and governmental organizations."

The program is an annual cohort of 30 individuals, chosen by application, who are brought together to learn about our community's issues, leaders, and resources to help facilitate positive change for our city. **Liz** described the typical schedule that is followed each year, including:
